“SRT has stepped up big time in giving Stage 3 this forum to kick off fundraising for finding a permanent home. When this preview night became available to us we snapped it up. There is no better place to present theatregoers our positive program to reestablish Stage 3 in historic downtown Sonora,” said Olga Jones, Stage 3 co-chair. “During the last year SRT has demonstrated, time and time again, that it feels a rising tide lifts all boats when it comes to theater and especially Community Theater in the Mother Lode. Its generosity and support cannot be praised enough,” said Jones.

Jones also announced that the theatre company is still looking for a permanent home for the 2019-2020 season. “Our efforts have been productive and informative but no affordable permanent home has jumped out to the Stage 3 board. We have concluded it will take someone in the

business community to step up with creative ideas and possible funding or a possible government/private sector arrangement to establish a cultural arts venue in downtown. Either way, the entire arts community will win since Stage 3 has always cooperated with local artists and local arts groups that are now also looking for outside help,” Jones offered. She also said the Stage 3 board while preparing future fundraising events, is looking for local arts partners who can coalesce to form “fundraising partnerships” such as the one SRT and Stage 3 have initiated with this preview event.

Intimate Apparel is a play written by [Lynn Nottage](#). The play is set in New York City in 1905 and concerns a young African-American woman who travels to New York to pursue her dreams, becoming an independent woman as a [seamstress](#).
